The role:

Key responsibilities and features of this job:

- Odour Management Plans owner responsible for their implementation and for updating them in accordance with all contractual and / or regulatory requirements.
- Ensuring operational employees are trained on all procedural requirements of the Odour Management plans including any updates.
- Monitoring & reporting of site performance against Odour Management Plans for all key stakeholders.
- Liaison with key stakeholders on all aspects of the Odour Management Plan including attendance at Odour Liaison Meetings.
- Production of systems for monitoring odour performance including relevant Key performance Indicators and alerting Operations of potential breaches of Odour Management Plans.
- Production and implementation of rectification plans for resolving non-conformances with Odour Management Plans
- Lead on investigating customer complaints and their reporting; ensure that Odour Management Plans requirements with respect to complaints is adhered to outside normal working hours
- Management of contract for the analysis of samples taken for demonstrating performance of odour control processes
- Manage the operation of all odour control processes and work with Operations to optimise performance.
- Undertake regular inspections of odour control infrastructure to ensure the condition is as required to deliver all contractual and / or regulatory requirements.
- Monitoring and assessment of odour performance including the odour control processes, the assessment of odour levels across the site and off-site where required.
- Monitoring of customer complaints and liaise with Scottish Water and City of Edinburgh council representatives to ensure completeness and accuracy of records
- Keep up to date with improvements in Odour management and best industry practice from other sites and Veolia and other organisations and represent Seafield as a reference site.
- Marketing of odour improvements through site visits and publications

Qualifications, knowledge, skills and experience

- Degree and higher degree in water/wastewater treatment processes/environmental pollution control.
- Capable of understanding all aspects of contractual requirements including the application of performance related penalties
- Knowledge / Experience of wastewater treatment process control and optimisation; particularly odour control.
